DRAG RACING

At ANDRA Sportsman Championship rounds Groups 2, 3, and 4 may be run as per the Group One Three Round Format racing or Shootout Style Format racing at the discretion of the Meeting Director.

- NOTE: For any ANDRA Sportsman Championship Group 2, 3 and 4 Eliminator to be contested, a minimum of four (4) entrants must attempt to qualify.
- NOTE: Where Super Comp is run, points awarded will transfer directly to nominated Class Eliminator.
- NOTE: No vehicle may be entered more than once in the one event, regardless of intended classing.

Shootout Style Format:

- Points will be allocated on the basis of 20 points for round win and 10 points for a round loss. The highest points scorers from the three racing rounds compete in a final, deciding the winner and runner up.
- For Handicap and Index Racing Where more than two competitors are tied on points after 3 rounds the tie breaker will be best performance against the Handicap/Index in Round 3, which results in a Round 3 win. Second tie breaker will be best performance against the Handicap/Index in Round 2, which results in a Round 2 win.
- For Dial Your Own Racing Where more than two competitors are tied on points after three rounds the tie breaker will be the Best Package* in Round 3, which results in a Round 3 win. Second tie breaker will be the Best Package* in Round 2, which results in a Round 2 win.
- In situations where a competitor is making a solo run in Round 3, they are
 considered the automatic winner once they stage and receive the green
 light, regardless of a Break Out and/or a red light.

* Best Package means the competitor's reaction time plus the deviation from the dial-in.

Group 2 Performance Bonus Points: Points will be allocated for the Top Qualifier in Group 2 classes and for setting an Elapsed Time National Record and/or Top Speed (mph) National Record.

Achievement	Points
Top Qualifier	10 points
ET Record	5 points
TS (mph) Record	5 points

NOTE: Group 2 Performance Bonus Points will not be counted towards the John Storm Memorial Trophy.

Travel Bonus Points: A 50% bonus for points scored at the Hidden Valley or Alice Springs or Perth Motorplex rounds will be applied where at least one additional ANDRA Sportsman Championship round is contested in the same season.

The 50% travel bonus points will be applied to the round the competitor gathers the most points at.
